Authorized security personnel can push targeted or broad emergency alerts to Help Stations with voice instructions, text display, flashing lights, and sirens.

The Emergency Help Station can be mounted on the outside walls of buildings to inform people to shelter inside during severe weather events or violent incidents, or to warn them to remain outside until it's safe to enter. It can also be used for Area of Refuge communications in locations where a ruggedized device is needed.
